#### Calf Club Day - Thursday 18 October 2018

If you haven't already, you need to start thinking now if your child/ren want to rear a lamb or goat for Calf Club Day. The animal must be born after 1st July 2018. Lambs & Goats are judged on rearing, leading & calling.
