Measles Update

A reminder that year 7 students who have not been immunised will not be permitted to attend technology classes at Hukerenui School next week due to an outbreak at that school. We are aware that a number of cases of measles have appeared in other Whangarei Schools, so it may only be a matter of time before we have cases of measles at Matarau School. Parents are reminded to monitor their children closely, and to keep them at home if they suspect measles. It is possible that the school may be asked by health authorities to ensure that unimmunised children do not attend Matarau School for a specified period should we have an outbreak in our school.
