#### <u>Carona Virus - being prepared</u>

At its next meeting the board will confirm the details of our Pandemic Plan. Our goal is to be prepared in advance for each stage in the spread of this virus, to keep your children, our staff and you as safe as we can, and to continue your child's education by distance should the school be closed. We also want to communicate with you moving forward on what measures we are taking, and how you can help. Measures we have taken to date include a near doubling of the number of liquid soap and paper towel dispensers, regular instruction on hand washing, disinfection of all high risk surfaces daily, measures to assist us to cope with staff absences, and firm requests that unwell children are kept at home, or sent home if they present with symptoms of concern.

#### It is critical that we have your help by

... ensuring that children with a cough, persistent sneezing, runny nose, vomiting, diarrhoea or fever are kept at home. As a precaution, children arriving at school with any of these symptoms will be put in isolation and pick up will be requested as soon as possible. If both parents work, we suggest that you have a Plan B which can be immediately put in place if your child is sick. This might involve a neighbour, friend or relative.

... ensuring that your child is free of symptoms for at least 48 hours before they return to school. NB - these are draft protocols at present and will be confirmed by month's end. The board will be guided by advice from health authorities and our response will change as the situation changes.
