Promotion of Reading ... coming up

There is quite a bit of anecdotal evidence (but not a lot of published research) that fewer children are reading than in earlier generations, or maybe that they are reading different things in different ways. A number of studies have suggested that, for reasons which are not fully known, that reading from actual books (hard cover, pages to turn), and writing with a pen or pencil (as opposed to a keyboard), improves literacy in ways which cannot be replicated via a screen. In coming months, we want to really get kids reading ... (books!). We have an amazing library and we are going to take a closer look at who is taking books out, what they are taking out, how long they have it for etc. We are keen to help children to find the books that engage and excite them personally, as a way to hook them into a genre that works for them, and to ultimately grow their reading mileage. This will take time but should be well worth the effort. So the approach we are likely to take will be two fold ...

... to replace (at least some) screen time with book time (home and school)

... to assist each child on a journey towards genre (i.e. a journey to find the right books for them) If we are to have an impact, we need you with us. We will be inviting you to assist with the above, especially with respect to replacing screen time with book time. Screens are addictive, and so we know this will not be easy, but we think it will be worth the effort.

We want to work with you to grow the reading culture you have at home, knowing you will already be doing amazing things. So ... more to follow.

Yesterday those children who participated in our lockdown Virtual Talent Show received signed letters from the Prime Minister acknowledging their efforts and talents.
