<u>Mid-year Interviews</u>

<u>Monday 3 August & Tuesday 4 August (plus the additional day of 5 August - Year 7 & 8 only)</u>

Our online interview booking system is now open. Interviews are booked on a first in basis. Please note that we have 2 concurrent interview cycles this year. You will need to book under 2 different codes (see below) ... On interview nights the change-over bells will ring every 15 minutes as per normal, but these bells will apply to the year 1 to 6 interviews only. The year 7 and 8 interviews will be of 10 minutes duration, all of these interviews will be held in room 11, and change overs will be at the direction of the teachers. All 3 senior school teachers will be present at the year 7 and 8 interviews. If you have children in years 1 to 6 <u>and</u> in year 7 and 8, please remember that times will overlap and so we suggest that you book your year 7 and 8 slot with spare slots either side to avoid double ups.

Junior and Middle School (years 1 to 6) the code is ywcwz Senior School (year 7 and 8) the code is sm4wz

If you do not have access to the internet, or if you have any questions, please give Paula a call on Monday. Please note that teachers are available at other times by appointment.

(Please note that on 3 and 4 August school will finish at 2:30 pm to allow teachers time to prepare for interviews and buses will run 30 minutes earlier. On 5 August (<u>which is the</u> <u>additional year 7 and 8 interview day</u>) school will finish at the usual time of 3:00pm with no changes to bus departure times).

<u>Parent / teacher interviews</u>

To get the most out of interviews, and to keep things flowing please ...

- ... arrive on time and move on the bell
- ... note down any questions or concerns beforehand
- ... please note that these interviews exist primarily for the sharing of achievement information, and that a second appointment can be made to discuss other (or deeper) issues.

... remember that year 1 to 6 interviews change on the bell. Year 7 and 8 interviews will be held in room 11 and will change at the termination of each 10 minute interview period.

... please note that children are not required at mid-year interviews

Please also note that it is possible that a second teacher may sit in on one of your interviews. This does not indicate a concern. Teachers are asked to sit in on at least one other interview for professional development purposes. All matters discussed are kept confidential.

School Headlice Inspections

Headlice inspections this week indicated some level of infestation. If you received a letter advising of infestation, or suspected infestation, please treat your child's hair before their return to school on Monday, this will enable us to keep on top of this problem, and reduce the overall level of use of chemicals. All parents are asked to check their children's hair weekly please and to treat immediately if here is evidence of infestation. Let us know if we can help.
