Term Headlice Inspection

It is highly important, if you received notification of infestation, or suspected infestation, that you treat your child if you have not already done so. We are happy to put parents requiring support or guidance in touch with our public health nurse.

<u>A wee reminder - Fitness for school - Covid precautions remain in place</u> It is ABSOLUTELY CRITICAL that sick children are NOT sent to school. There are no conditions that would warrant this. To send a sick child puts other children, and staff, at risk, and could have serious knock-on effects. So, if your child has a cough, a sore throat, head or body aches, fever, breathlessness etc., please keep them home and seek medical advice if necessary. Please keep them at home for a minimum of 48 hours after cessation of final symptoms, or longer on the advice of their doctor ... always err on the side of caution. We suggest that you have a contingency plan in place in the event that your child is unwell, or in the event that the school contacts you with a request that you pick up your child. If you are contacted by the school to pick your child up please arrange this promptly, a staff member will be waiting for you.
