Parents are asked by these organisations to give serious attention to the following suggestions ... THINGS PARENTS SHOULD NOT DO ... DO NOT ...! * Constantly instruct your child × argue with the referee × shout at your child × argue with other parents * dissect every game with your child × get angry at a match * shout at other children * storm off in the middle of a game * be critical of your child's performance * be critical of any other child's performance INSTEAD - DO ...! ✓ support ✓ encourage ✓ tell them you are proud of them praise inspire ✓ motivate

Remember to affirm and support coaches and managers often and to be overwhelmingly positive with the kids.


Honey is available at the school office. The price is **\$8** for an approx. 500g jar.
