Final Word

An on-going thank you to those parents who have been keeping us informed of positive covid results and isolation periods. Your efforts have enabled us to get a very good picture of the rate of spread. It is our strong impression that children want to be at school with their friends and their teachers, and that face to face learning is the preference for most children (and parents). So our goal is to have as many children at school as possible for as long as possible. A special thank you to those parents in our phase/stage 1 group (i.e. those very keen to distance learn if this became advisable), I am sorry that you are still on hold, but the rates of spread of the virus has been slower than expected, and so we are drawing out the period of "at school" learning for the moment. We will review next week and keep you posted. Around 30% of our students are now on distance learning or similar (so classes on average are down by a third) but we have no obviously symptomatic children at school, and we have enough staff to manage classes at present. We are not sure why the spread is happening slower than in other schools, but let's celebrate that fact.
