MATARAU SCHOOL Conditions of Enrolment

This form is to be read, signed and dated by the student and both parents or legal guardians

RULES AND REGULATIONS

I/We undertake to ensure that the student applying for enrolment at Matarau School shall abide by all the laws of New Zealand and by the rules of the school.

International Students referred to in this form are students enrolled at Matarau School who do NOT have permanent residence or citizenship in New Zealand.

RULES OF MATARAU SCHOOL

At all times students are expected to ..

- 1) Conduct themselves in an orderly, courteous fashion
- 2) Demonstrate respect towards staff, fellow pupils and visitors to the school
- 3) Respect the property of school and others
- 4) Be punctual and attend class each day the school is open
- 5) Adhere to the schools behaviour management policy
- 6) Apply themselves conscientiously to assigned tasks
- 7) Abide by rules for the smooth operation of classroom and schools

Additionally ...

- 1) Students may not bring dangerous items or substances to school
- 2) Students are to reside in homestay accommodation approved by the school unless permission to do otherwise is granted by the Director of Foreign Fee Paying Studies.

DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

Any disciplinary action taken in respect of an international student will be in accordance with natural justice and as outlined in the schools Behaviour Management Policy. Matters of a very serious natural may result in the termination of a student's enrolment.

ACCOMMODATION

- 1) Matarau School does not arrange homestay accommodation for international students enrolled in the school. The school recommends approved outside agents which may be used for this purpose and monitors the services of these agents as required under the Code of Practice for the Pastoral Care of International Students.
- 2) All homestay costs are payable by the student

INSURANCE AND LIABILITY

- 1) Matarau School shall not be liable for any damage to property or persons, however caused, except where such liability is required under New Zealand law.
- 2) Matarau School reserves the right to make reasonable variations to a course of study where it is deemed to be in the interests of students or as dictated by circumstances which could not have been anticipated by the school.
- 3) Matarau School reserves the right to decline enrolment in the school at the discretion of the Director of Foreign Fee Paying Studies.
- 4) Prior to commencing study at Matarau School students MAY be required to undergo ,and make available to the school, a full medical examination by a doctor of the school's choice.
- 5) All disputes will be dealt with in accordance with New Zealand law and in New Zealand courts

PAYMENT OF FEES

- 1) A deposit consisting of the first terms fees (\$3,000) must be paid prior to 15 December of the previous year to secure placement in the programme (or by June 15 if enrolling for terms 3 and 4)
- 2) Fees for the remaining terms (\$3,000) per term must be paid before the end of the preceding term for the term which follows.
- 3) Homestay fees must be paid in accordance with the conditions specified by the homestay agent.

REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS

- 1) Where a student withdraws from a programme prior to the commencement of this programme a full refund of tuition and homestay fees will be made less general administrative expenses and any other fees incurred by the board in processing the said enrolment. These fees will usually be \$500.
- 2) Where a student withdraws during the first term of study no refund fees for that term shall be paid.
- 3) Where a student withdraws within 7 days after commencement of the second, third or fourth term of study a full refund of fees paid shall be made less the cost of any administrative or additional fees incurred by the board and the cost of tuition (including cost of personnel, materials, use of facilities) up to the date of withdrawal.
- 4) Where a student withdraws more than 7 days after commencement of a second, third or fourth term of study refund of tuition fees for that term shall not normally be paid.
- 5) Requests for a refund of fees shall be made in writing to the principal who has discretion on the payment and amount of any refund.

FEE PROTECTION

A fee protection policy operates to ensure that Matarau School is able to meet its refund obligations. This policy ensures that tuition fees are spent on a term basis and only for the term in question. Fees paid for any future term will be held in reserve in the school account.

WITHDRAWAL FROM PROGRAMME

- 1) Application for withdrawal from the programme will need to be made in writing to the Board of Trustees which will apply the refund conditions outlined in this document.
- 2) In the event of withdrawal the New Zealand Immigration Service will be immediately advised.
- 3) The study visa is valid for study at Matarau School. Should a parent decide to enrol their child in a different institution a prior application must be made to New Zealand Immigration Service for an amendment to their study permit.

TRANSFER OF CARE

In the event of a transfer of care arrangements for student a written letter of intent should be submitted in advance to ensure that the transfer meets the requirements of the school and of the Code. Caregiver safety checks will be undertaken at the school's discretion.

Please note that the school is not responsible for the day-to-day care of a student when that student is in the care of a supervisor appointment by the parent to that role.

DECLARATION

We, the students and parents, have received, read and understand the conditions of enrolment stated on this form.

We have also received and read a copy of the Code of Practice for The Pastoral Care of International Students and understand that the school is bound by the conditions of this code.

I/We authorise Matarau School to collect, store, use and disclose the information provided on this form for the purpose of enrolment, general administration and the care and welfare of my/our child during the period of their enrolment at Matarau School and we agree to update this information where necessary.

I/We authorise the school to administer any medication and/or treatment as outlined by us in the enrolment form or otherwise as may be considered necessary by a registered medical practitioner of the school's choice and to meet the cost of this treatment.

I/We further certify that the information on this form and as generally submitted to the school (including medical details) is correct and complete.

Enrolment Form

Enrolment Procedure

- 1) Please complete the attached enrolment form and return it to the Director of Foreign Fee Paying Studies at the address shown
- 2) Your completed enrolment will need to be received by the school by 15 October at the latest -or later with prior permission of the Director of studies. (Or by 15 April if enrolling for terms 3 and 4)
- 3) Remember to enclose school reports and a recent photograph
- 4) If successful, by November 15, you will receive an offer of a place and an invoice for fees payable. (15 May if enrolling for terms 3 and 4)
- 5) Payment can be made by cheque or by direct transfer to the school's bank account. Account details will be stated on the invoice.
- 6) Payment must be made by December 15 (or alternatively with the permission of the Director of Studies) or you will automatically forfeit your offer of placement. Payments must be made by June 15 if enrolling for terms 3 and 4)
- 7) Upon receipt of tuition fees you will receive ...
- A receipt
- A letter of acceptance stating nature and duration of course of study

Please note that for immigration and enrolment purposes you will also need a "Guarantee of Suitable Accommodation" from a homestay agent approved by the school.

CONDITIONS OF HOMESTAY PLACEMENT AT MATARAU SCHOOL

- 1) A homestay co-ordinator shall be employed by the Board of Trustees to place, monitor and offer care and support to international students.
- 2) All efforts shall be made to place students in homestays suited to their circumstances and needs
- 3) Parents of the foreign fee paying student take full responsibility for their child's placement in homestay accommodation and delegate to the school and caregiver responsibility for meeting (and making decisions) on the day to day requirements of their child.
- 4) Students who are unable to settle or who behave in an unacceptable manner in a homestay situation may have their place in the programme terminated at a minimum of two weeks notice.
- 5) Fees must be paid in advance in a minimum of 12 week instalmants
- 6) Fees shall be paid to the school which will then disburse them minthly on the students behalf
- 7) Money covered to host families covers all meals and laundry. Students are responsible for purchasing their own personal items and toiletries and for the cost of any phonecalls.
- 8) All international students will be provided with their own furnished bedroom including blankets and linen (replaced weekly) and a desk or table for study purposes.
- 9) The student may be required to meet the cost of transport to and from school.
- 10) Time away from host families shall be refunded as follows
 Up to 7 days no refund
 \$15 per day refund for each consecutive day after that

I have read and accept these homestay conditions.

- 11) Students are required to be fully insured and no responsibility will be taken by the school or the homestay provider (whether organised by the parents, the school or the school's agents) for personal injury loss or damage of any kind.
- 12) Cancellation fees equivalent to two weeks homestay payment will be deducted from students who leave early or who are excluded from the programme for behavioural reasons
