At this time each year the parents of year 6 children receive printed information on our year 7 and 8 programme. This programme provides an exceptional start to secondary school and positions our students for success. Former students consistently tell us how well prepared they were for the demands of secondary school, with many of them transitioning quickly to more advanced learning.
