We know from experience that three things must happen for this to be effective ...

- ... there needs to be at least one time each term when there is a coordinated check at home across all families (to reduce re-infestation rates).
- ... that in the event of infestation action will need to be undertaken (ideally) within a 48 hour period.
- ... that throughout the year parents undertake regular checks at home.

If you are dealing with repeat infestations post-treatment, please let us know and (without using names) we will discretely advise parents of pockets of infestation so that they can be extra vigilant.
