## <u> Matarau School Colour Run – Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> December</u>

This year, parents and other family members are invited to run with their child!

The cost of this event is \$10 per participant, maximum \$50 per family. This needs to be paid BEFORE the <u>8th of December.</u> The cost will cover the powdered paint for each participant, as

well as a great experience of completing a selection of obstacles course activities ranging from waterslides, crawling under nets, dodging water pistols, negotiating a maze etc.!

Each syndicate will rotate through the obstacle course. Nonparticipants will be watching their class complete the obstacle course from the grass bank.

Participants are to wear an old WHITE (or light coloured) shirt, and old shorts. These clothing items will most likely come home covered

with powdered paint, so please don't allow your child to wear good or new clothes. Students are to bring a change of clothes and a bag to transport 'coloured' clothes home in. To protect eyes, we strongly recommend wearing safety glasses, sunglasses, or swimming goggles.
